About the School:

This school will teach basic gas and gas liquid chromatography with an introduction to extended analysis and portable chromatographs. This is a hands-on school directed toward chromatograph operators, measurement technicians and engineers involved with chromatography. It has three primary purposes:

- To teach GPA chromatography procedures and calculation methods to industry technicians and chemists with hands-on instruction.
- To prove that accurate and reproducible results can be obtained by chromatographic analysis.
- To provide related auxiliary information on fundamental chemistry, gas and liquid sampling, reference standard blends, safety practices related to pressurized cylinders, integrators, economics of extended analysis, portable chromatographs and contaminants in NGLs. In addition, a laboratory demonstration of non-linearity will be included. Various laboratory equipment vendors will perform on-site demonstrations of their products and answer any questions students may have.

The school will consist of a combination of lectures, demonstrations and chromatograph operation. Lectures will be minimal, approximately one to two hours per day. Emphasis will be on machine demonstration and operation. Both natural gas and natural gas liquid samples will be analyzed. Reference materials needed for class will be provided at the school. Be sure you have extra room in your suitcase to get this material home.
